Transport Logistic Munich Fair 2011

POSMETRANS Project will be a part of Transport Logistic Fair (http://www.transportlogistic.de/en) that will take place at the New Munich Trade Fair Centre $10^{th} - 13^{th}$ May 2011. During the fair the POSMETRANS Consortium organizes the Panel of Experts (who are going to be identified by the means of the abovementioned questionnaires). In this way the consortium will validate the analysis of market adoption of innovative technologies (best practices), the analysis of network-related policies and the impact of policy measures. At least 24 experts will be nominated for Experts Panel from different fields of transportation sector.

POSMETRANS PROJECT at the info day Cracow, Poland - November 9th, 2010



Technology Transfer Centre Cracow University of Technology organized the info day entitled "Transport in 7th Framework Programme". Representatives of National and Regional Contact points presented the current Work Programme, ongoing and planned Calls for Proposals in the Transport Theme in FP7. In the part dedicated to the projects realized under this theme, Dr. Andrzej Szarata presented POSMETRANS project, its goals, the project's consortium and its current activities. He also invited participants to take part in the forthcoming POSMETRANS works as stakeholders and experts.

POSMETRANS PROJECT at the

annual Logistic Congress of Baden-Wuerttemberg Stuttgart, Germany - November 10th, 2010

The annual Logistic Congress of the region of Baden-Wuerttemberg was organised by Steinbeis-Europa-Zentrum on behalf of the regional Ministry of Economics. The Statistics of the Federal Employment Office show that in 2009 almost 180,000 people have been employed in the logistic sector in the region of Baden-Wuerttemberg. In terms of its economic importance, it is the third most important industry after mechanical engineering and



automotive construction. Baden–Württemberg also serves as a transit point and source for major flows of goods. This is the reason why the regional Ministry organises an annual event specific for logistic stakeholders in the region to support the dialogue between the actors. More than 250 participants took part at the 3rd congress hold under the slogan "innovation through networking". One core output was the official start of the new Logistic Cluster of Baden-Wuerttemberg (LogBW) financed with 500.000 € of ERDF funds during the next three years. Steinbeis-Europa-Zentrum had an own booth at the congress and gave a small overview in regard of POSMETRANS objectives and strategy. The staffs of SEZ used the event to make surveys among the participants. It is planned to present the outcomes in a separate forum at the annual congress in 2011.

POSMETRANS PROJECT at ITN Turin, 11th and 12th November 2010 Presentation & Collection of questionnaires



Infrastructure, Telematics & Navigation Fair (ITN) was successfully organised for the second time in Turin on 11th and 12th November 2010. ITN was developed from the combination of two former events: Infrastructura, an international biennial show dedicated to infrastructural facilities and the conference & expo Telemobility Forum. Last year 3000 visitors were there: 77% Italian and 23% foreigners.

This year the focus was on following fields:



Once again, ITN has been the ideal venue for discussing current and future developments in smart infrastructures, smart grids, GPS, Galileo, GIS, telematics and navigation services during a two-day event featuring informational conferences, networking programs and highly specialized seminars.

In the framework of the Second Summit of the Infomobility operators, Unioncamere Piemonte made a presentation of the POSMETRANS project on 11th November 2010.



Around 30 people (companies, researchers and policy makers) attended the round table. This event was very successful: the audience was very interested and asked questions even after the speech when Unioncamere Piemonte staff could give some project brochures.

POSMETRANS objectives and activities were promoted to people having lots of business relationships not only on a regional scale but on a European one.

The following day, on 12th November 2010, a brokerage event was organised by the Enterprise Europe Network local consortium to which Unioncamere Piemonte belongs.

There were 57 participants (52 enterprises, 2 research centres, one university and 2 "Other") coming from Italy (47), France, UK, Greece, Germany, Algeria, Spain and Sweden. They had 158 meetings.

During the brokerage event, Unioncamere Piemonte seized the opportunity for administering some questionnaires to innovative companies. A face-to-face approach was very appreciated by the respondents who could ask questions and get answers immediately.

Electric-mobility technology day Stuttgart, Germany - November 26th, 2010

The question how the technological change from combustion mobility to electric mobility can be used for growing businesses was in the focus of the 1st e-mobility technology day of Baden-Wuerttemberg. The latter was organized by the new founded regional e-mobility agency and supported by various partners among them Steinbeis-Europa-Zentrum. At its booth the staffs of SEZ informed about POSMETRANS the project approach and strategy. The technology day was used to make project specific surveys with participants on a face-to-face basis.





Transport in FP7

The central objective of transport research under FP7 is to develop safer, greener and smarter transport systems for Europe that will benefit citizens, respect the environment, and increase the competitiveness of European industries in the global market.

The EU Member States have earmarked a total of € 4.16 billion for funding this theme over the duration of FP7.

The funds are designed for the following activities:

Aeronautics and air transport
reduction of emissions, work on engines and alternative fuels,
air traffic management, safety aspects of air transport,
environmentally efficient aviation

Sustainable surface transport - rail, road and waterborne
development of clean and efficient engines and power trains,
reducing the impact of transport on climate change,
inter-modal regional and national transport,
clean and safe vehicles,
infrastructure construction and maintenance, integrative architectures.
